The Hawera BMX Club have an emergency evacuation point – High Road Car park, opposite the Hawera BMX track main gate entrance - and will ensure people are not exposed to hazards.

Hawera BMX Club expects anyone using this facility to observe and practice safe methods to ensure a safe and healthy facility, as well as ensuring that no action or inaction on their part causes harm to any other person.

Safety and safe practices with Hawera BMX Club is not negotiable and failure by anyone to not abide by any agreed rule will result in the removal of such person from these premises.
